How can you tell if the kitten you've found is sick or injured?



SIGNS OF A SICK KITTEN:

- Thin stomachs and gaunt faces, visible ribs and spine
- Cold ears, bellies, and paws
- Pale gums and tongues
- Lethargy/almost no movement
- Excessively crusted eyes or nose
- Diarrhea or vomiting
- Struggling to breath

SIGNS OF AN INJURED KITTEN:

- Limping
- Visible wounds or sores
- Crying out in pain
